

EACR 2026 Budapest – Turbine HQ

Terms & Conditions

By registering for and attending the EACR 2026 Budapest event hosted by Turbine Hálózatelemző Kutatási Fejlesztési Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság (“Turbine”), you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions.

1. Laboratory Access and Safety Rules

Visitors participating in the laboratory tour or entering any laboratory area must comply with the following rules:

- The purpose of these Rules and Regulations is to ensure the safety, health, and physical well-being of visitors present in the Turbine laboratory, as well as to maintain the uninterrupted operation of the laboratory environment.
- Research activities conducted within the laboratory involve the handling of hazardous chemicals, biological agents, and cytotoxic substances. These activities may generate hazardous waste, including but not limited to infectious and chemical waste. Consequently, the laboratory environment is classified as a high-risk area.
- Access to the laboratory is permitted only when accompanied by an authorized Turbine employee. Visitors are required to fully comply with all instructions provided by the accompanying staff member and may move only along the designated route specified by them.
- Visitors may touch or handle laboratory equipment, instruments, samples, chemicals, or any other materials solely with explicit permission. Unauthorized interference, movement, or contact with any object or material is strictly prohibited.

- Audio or video recording within the laboratory area – including photography or video recording using mobile phones – is permitted only with prior written authorization.
- Food and beverages are strictly prohibited within the laboratory premises. Backpacks, bags, coats, and other personal belongings must be left outside the laboratory in the designated area. Visitors must ensure that personal items are not placed on work surfaces and that no objects or waste are left behind within the laboratory area.
- The use of the provided protective shoe covers is mandatory at all times while inside the laboratory. Upon completion of the visit, thorough hand washing and use of the provided disinfectant are required.
- If a visitor experiences dizziness, irritation, discomfort, illness, or any unusual symptoms, they must immediately notify the accompanying staff member. Likewise, any accidental contact with laboratory equipment, materials, samples, or any unintended movement of objects must be reported without delay. In such cases, the visitor is required to follow the instructions of the accompanying staff member.
- By entering the laboratory premises, the visitor acknowledges that they have read, understood, and accepted these Rules and Regulations as binding upon themselves.
- Turbine shall not be held liable for any damage, personal injury, or health impairment resulting from failure to comply with these Rules and Regulations. In the event of any violation of the rules, Turbine reserves the right to remove the visitor from the laboratory premises with immediate effect.

2. Use of Registration Information

By registering for the event, you agree that Turbine may process and use the information you provide during registration, including your name, email address, professional title, company name, and corporate position or title, for the purposes of:

- administering and organizing the event;
- communicating with you regarding the event;
- informing you about future Turbine-hosted events, programs, and related activities; and
- internal marketing, business development, and community-building activities of Turbine.

Turbine will not sell, rent, or disclose your registration information to third parties for their independent marketing purposes.

3. Photography and Video Recording

Photography, audio recording, and video recording may take place during the event.

By attending the event, you grant Turbine and its affiliates the right to photograph, film, record, and otherwise capture your likeness, image, voice, name, and appearance and to use, reproduce, publish, distribute, display, edit, and create derivative materials from such recordings in any media or format, whether now known or later developed, for Turbine's promotional, marketing, communications, educational, recruiting, public relations, archival, and other legitimate business purposes, without compensation or further approval.

4. Acceptance

Completion of the event registration process and attendance at the event constitute your acceptance of these Terms & Conditions. If you do not agree to these Terms & Conditions, you should not register for or attend the event. In the event of any violation of these Terms & Conditions, Turbine reserves the right to deny entry to or remove the participant from the event with immediate effect.
